Since its opening in 1912, Tampa Union Station has stood the test of time. It has served Tampa travelers in a changing world—through 18 U.S. Presidents, two World Wars, and the Great Depression. Millions of train passengers have passed though Tampa Union Station, in good times and bad, and still do (150,000 in 2012, up from 42,000 ten years ago!).

Now it's our turn to stand by her. The station is on the National Register of Historic Places and is a City of Tampa designated Landmark. Once endangered, it was restored in 1998. It is now owned by the citizens of Tampa through their municipal government.

A permanent endowment fund for Tampa Union Station is now being built at the Community Foundation of Tampa Bay. Proceeds from this endowment fund will help care for and enhance Tampa Union Station for the future.

Tampa Union Station was built in 1912 by the Atlantic Coast Line, Seaboard Air Line and Tampa Northern. In 2012 150,000 Amtrak passengers boarded or detrained from Silver Star in Tampa, 413 per day, making TUS the third busiest station in Florida after Sanford - Amtrak Auto Train (260,000) and Orlando (170,000). Silver Star serves many cities from New York to Miami and connects with the national network at several points. Amtrak bus service also connects to Silver Meteor in Orlando.
